

The Archbishop of Canterbury's Call to the Global Wave of Prayer 2017

Days of Prayer between Ascension and Pentecost (25 May - 4 June) During the days between Ascension and Pentecost, the intention is to pray for the evangelisation of our nation, our communities, and even our churches, at the initiation of Archbishop Justin Welby. He asks us to pray for more people to come to know Jesus Christ.

It may seem strange to include 'our churches', but as we pray between two great Festivals of the church – Ascension and Pentecost – we are waiting, as the first disciples did – for the outpouring of the promised Holy Spirit which comes to transform nations, communities, people. It is the work of the Spirit that brings people to an intimate knowledge of Jesus Christ.

It is the work of the Spirit that helps us know Jesus Christ better.

In this booklet there is the opportunity to take some time each day to pray very simply, with a prayer, a scripture reading, some suggestions to consider from the reading, the Lord's Prayer, and a final prayer.

You may wish to also use the prayer below, written especially for this initiative of 'Thy Kingdom Come', at the beginning and/or end of each day.

Almighty God, your ascended Son has sent us into the world to preach the good news of your kingdom: inspire us with your Spirit and fill our hearts with the fire of your love, that all who hear your Word may be drawn to you, through Jesus Christ our Lord.

## Thursday 25 May: Ascension Day

# Saturday 27 May

### **Prayer:**

**Read**: John 16.23-28

**Consider**: Joy is distinctly lacking in most parts of life. It is a gift which is more than happiness: it is something deeper, found only from knowing Christ. What might life look like – everywhere – when 'our joy is made complete'?

# Sunday 28 May – Easter 7

## **Prayer:**

**Read:** Acts 1.12-14

Consider: After the Lord's Ascension, people were in the upper room, 'constantly devoting themselves to prayer'. Does this challenge our own life of prayer, and that of our Christian communities? How do we pray together, and what should be we pray for? Does how we pray as communities need re-thinking?

Yet, Jesus says: 'Take Courage, I have conquered the world'. Imagine Jesus speaking those words to you. Do things feel different? How different?

Read: John 17.1-11

**Consider:** Jesus prays to the Father 'that we may be one'. What further steps need to be taken that we may indeed 'be one'? How might we pray for greater unity in our churches and community, and how can it be realized?

### **Prayer:**

**Read:** Romans 12.9-16

Consider: Here we are told how Christians ought to live. The words go to the very heart of our faith: they don't feel particularly easy or comfortable, do they? Pray for the Spirit to cleanse us of wrongdoing, that the world may see Christ's love within us.

# **Thursday 1 June**

### **Prayer:**

Come Holy Spirit,

Fill my life with power from on high,

And make me a more faithful witness to Christ.

Read: John 17.20-21

**Consider:** This part of Jesus' High Priestly Prayer to His Father, pleads for those who will believe in Him because of the words spoken on His behalf. What witness are we to the love of Christ in our community? What difference to our words have for those with whom we come into contact.

# Friday 2 June

### **Prayer:**

Come Holy Spirit,

Fill my life with power from on high,

And make me a more faithful witness to Christ.

Read: John 21.15-19

**Consider:** After breakfast Jesus and Peter have an intense and poignant conversation. It ends both simply and abruptly as Jesus says to Peter: 'Follow me'. We may have followed Jesus for many years, albeit falteringly; or we may have just begun. We need to hear the words 'Follow me', again and again. Pray for the transforming Holy Spirit to strengthen us in following Christ.

## Saturday 3 June

### **Prayer:**

Read: John 3:5-8

Consider: Jesus' conversation with Nicodemus, a leader of the Jews, reveals a spiritual truth, which confounds this learned man. The Spirit cannot be contained, its power and work is not limited. Like the wind it blows where it chooses. May we open our hearts and lives to the Spirit coming among us.

## **Sunday 4 June - The Feast of Pentecost**

### **Prayer:**

Come Holy Spirit,
Fill my life with power from on high,
And make me a more faithful witness to Christ.
Amen.

**Read:** Acts 2.1-13

**Consider:** The promised Spirit comes as they pray like the sound of a rushing wind, with divided tongues of fire. Confused people failed to grasp how the story of God's deeds could be heard in their own language. Pray that the nations may hear God's voice and peace may come. Pray for the church that it may be empowered to preach and live the good news. Pray for one another to live in the unity of the Spirit.

Holy Spirit, sent by the Father, ignite in us your holy fire; strengthen your children with the gift of faith, revive your Church with the breath of love, and renew the face of the earth, through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.
